 - 1. The gods of your fathers (Baal)
- C. Joshua is reminding the people
 - 1. God and Satan are fathers with children 1 John 3:10
 - 2. It's your choice, choose wisely

A. The God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob (Israel)
