  - A. I think I am O.K.
    - 1. I hope so
    - 2. I do my best
  - B. I am not good enough
    - 1. I have said and done some terrible things
    - 2. I feel I am beyond forgiveness
  - C. I am certain of my salvation because of what Jesus has done for me

### II. Why is confidence so important?

- A. Death is real
  - 1. It is permanent
  - 2. It is the door into Eternity
- B. Certainty is desired by all of us
- C. Heaven is real
- D. The desire for salvation/Heaven is essential to the human psyche
- E. The complaint of atheists
  - 1. Life is a cruel joke
  - 2. It ends quickly
  - 3. Then you are soon forgotten
- F. However for the believer this is "Act 1" of our

life

- G. This is why you truly don't know how to live until you have settled the issue of death
- III. How salvation (eternal life) comes to humanity
