- A. John 3:16
 - 1. It is about God's love
 - 2. It is about God's gift

 - 6. Prayer life mechanical
 - 7. Love to give God their resume
- B. Pharisee in the temple
 - 1. Tells God how great the Pharisee is
 - 2. He gives God his resume
- C. Publican/tax collector
 - 1. Hated by others
 - 2. In the temple
 - 3. Admits his problem
 - 4. A posture of humility
 - 5. His prayer life seeks mercy
